Chrysalis/Journeys Big House Expectations

We believe that God sends each person to the Big House for a special purpose. The Chrysalis/Journeys Board has put the following rules in place so the Big House will run smoothly and stays focused on its mission statement:

1. Applications (page one of this file) must be filled out completely and signed by a parent or guardian if under the age of 18. Positions will be filled on first-come, first-served basis. Mail applications with \$35.00. (Sending the money prior to the flight shows your commitment and helps purchase the food to feed you!) Your name will be added to the list when it reaches us. Please don't hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or concerns. *There are scholarships available but you must let us know by writing it on your application if one is needed.* **NOTE:** Your application must be received by Monday BEFORE the flight. **Late applications are subject to a \$10 late fee.**

2. Types of Butterflies

Visiting Butterflies: Those who can only come for a *limited time* to visit & serve

Resident Butterflies: Those who commit their time and bodily presence to the *entire weekend*

3. Resident Butterflies must be committed to staying at the Big House and participating in acts of fellowship, discipleship & servant hood from 8 a.m. on day one of the flight until after candlelight on day two, with the option of staying over through day three. If you need to leave for work, school or church functions, you must get prior approval before the weekend.(on application page).

4. Visiting Butterflies are welcome to come to the Big House for fellowship, service and growth.

Note the Big House "VISITING HOURS" below:

Saturday (or 1st day)	7:00 pm to 11:00 pm
Sunday (or 2 nd day)	4:30 pm to 12:00 midnight

NOTE: ONLY Resident Butterflies will serve candlelight dinner and perform for the caterpillars BUT during that time Visiting Butterflies will enjoy a time of sharing, devotions, worship & prayer in the Big House. Afterward, all Butterflies will eat together before going to candlelight. All Visiting Butterflies are welcome to take part in the candlelight service. If you are a Visiting Butterfly and want to come any other time during the weekend, you will be welcome in the kitchen or prayer chapel but won't be able to visit the Big House or Resident Butterflies until "VISITING HOURS"

5. Dress: All Butterflies are to dress appropriately in a manner that glorifies Christ. (Please, no extremely short tight or revealing clothes.) If you plan to serve candlelight dinner, guys should wear dress clothes and ladies should wear a skirt, dress or dress slacks. **Note:** Chrysalis/Journeys Board members have the authority to make decisions on questionable attire with two or more making the decision.

6. Sign-out: You need adult permission to leave the Recreations Complex and must sign in and out.

7. Music: We encourage you to bring music to the Big House but only Christian Music is allowed. Be sure to write you name on your CD's and CD cases!

8. Contact with team & caterpillars: In order to help each caterpillar focus on their relationship with Christ, every effort will be made to be sure there is no contact with caterpillars or team members (without permission).

9. Christian values: All dress, language and actions should represent Christian values and lift up Jesus Christ, the One we are here to love & serve.

10. What to bring: Be sure to bring a pillow, sleeping bag or blanket & linens for a twin bed, towel, Bible, semi-formal attire for special dinner, and *snacks & drinks to share.*

12. What NOT to bring: Personal electronics like game-boys, walkmans etc.
